Handmade Prison Reliefs, #6 - #11

The works in this show all come from a series called *Handmade Prison Reliefs*. Each one is numbered chronologically. I think these works have something to do with my sexuality. I'm curious about the perversion inherent to making a structure in an overdetermined, inefficient lost wax casting process, the reference to physical and emotional confinement among men by including "prison" in the title, and the cartoony appearance that partially results from hand-modeling the forms.

Arthur Stachurski (b.1991, Ridgewood, USA) is an American sculptor, who lives and works in London. He graduated from the Städelschule in 2024 and is currently enrolled in the postgraduate program at the Royal Academy of Arts in London. This marks his first solo presentation at the gallery.
